RESOLUTION No. 2009/10-10
A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING CENSUS DAY 2010

WHEREAS, the United States Bureau of the Census will conduct a National Census in the year 2010, the largest peacetime project undertaken by the federal government; and,

WHEREAS, the Census is mandated every ten years by the United States Constitution; and,

WHEREAS, the primary objective is to make Census 2010 the nation's most accurate and complete count, at the lowest cost possible; and,

WHEREAS, every resident is counted, no matter where they live or what language they speak; and,

WHEREAS, full cooperation by every possible unit of state and local government, school district, every possible church, community group, social service organization, and volunteer affinity group in the country is needed to provide the most accurate count; and,

WHEREAS, Census information will be used for the decennial apportionment of the United States House of Representatives among the states, and to redraw state and local legislative districts; is the primary tool used by government, business, and community organizations to base their decisions; and,


WHEREAS, Census data directly affect how more than \$300 billion per year in federal and state funding is allocated to communities for neighborhood improvements, public health, education, transportation; and,

WHEREAS, by law, Title IX of the United States Code, any and all census information collected is strictly confidential, and is not available to any other person or governmental agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lake Tahoe Unified School District hereby supports the efforts of the City of South Lake Tahoe to make Census Day, April 1, 2010, the most accurate and complete count, and encourages all persons living in the City South Lake Tahoe to participate.
