Our summer school program allows teachers and parents to further enrich the education of our students both academically and spiritually, as well as, give extra attention to those students who need it. The summer school program is designed to be fun while reinforcing the year's material and challenging the students with what is to come. The teachers, parents and volunteers take great pride in providing students with creative and enriching courses that are dedicated to academic excellence.

Summer School Registration

Classes will run Monday through Friday, June 22 to July 17, 2009.

Build Your Own Session:

Pick and choose classes that fit your schedule. You will need one registration form for each child you are enrolling. If you need additional forms please contact the office. Class sizes will be limited, so it is important that students register on or before June 5, 2009. **All schedules are final.**

Tuition and Fees

- All schedules are final. No refunds will be given for dropped classes.
- All registration fees must be submitted with the registration form(s).
- Fee Scale
 - Full Time (**8:30A.M. - 3:30P.M.**)
 - One child = \$125/week
 - Two children = \$200/week
 - Three children = \$250/week
 - Four children = \$300/week
 - Part Time (**8:30A.M. - 12:00P.M.**)
 - One child = \$100/week
 - Two children = \$175/week
 - Three children = \$225/week
 - Four children = \$275/week
 - Or \$10 a class
- Various classes may also require an additional supply fee. This is indicated in the course description for the effected class.
- One half of tuition and fees is due on or before June 5, 2009. The entire balance is due on or before the first day of summer school, June 22, 2009.
- Extended Care Program is available with an additional fee and is due each Monday throughout the summer sessions.

Collection of Past Due Payments

If one half of the total tuition is not paid by June 5, 2009, the family will be notified. The principal or the bookkeeper will contact the family the following week if arrangements have not been made. Any outstanding balance is due on or before the first day of summer school, June 22, 2009. Beginning on June 29, 2009, a \$25.00 a week late fee will be assessed to the account.

Refund Policy

There will be **no refunds for dropped classes** after June 22, 2009. Students may add classes at any time. Any changes to a student's schedule must be submitted in writing with a parent or guardian's signature before June 22, 2009.

Attendance Policy

Students are expected to regularly attend their classes. Although family vacation time is very important, please try to schedule vacations around your class schedules. In order for your child to receive the most benefit from each class, it is important that he/she attend each class period. Class tuition will not be pro-rated due to time missed because of vacation.

Recess and Lunch

There will be a supervised recess from 9:50 to 10:10 a.m. everyday. There is also a supervised lunch break from 12:00 p.m. to 12:55 p.m. No hot lunches will be available during summer school session. Students may also want to bring a snack(s).

Extended Care Program (ECP)

There will be ECP services only during the summer school program session. ECP hours will be from 3:30pm -6:00pm. ECP is only available to students who are enrolled in at least one summer school class per session at St. Theresa School.

Extended Care Program (ECP) Fees

Payment for the extended Care Program is made on each Monday for the week. Drop in payments can be made by the day. Any unpaid balance is due the Friday of that week. Any balance not paid by that Friday will be charged a \$10.00 late fee for every week it is overdue.
