POSITION: Substitute Teachers

DESCRIPTION: Lake Tahoe Unified School District is hiring on-call substitute teachers for the 2010-2011 school year.

QUALIFICATIONS: Qualified applicant must hold a valid California teaching credential or Emergency 30 Day Substitute Permit; or hold a BA/BS degree, and proof of passage of the CBEST exam (California Basic Education Skills Test). An out-of-state approved basic skills exam may be used in lieu of CBEST.

DESCRIPTION OF PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Position requires normal physical strength and endurance for standing, sitting, bending, or walking.
2. Vision sufficient to read printed materials; hearing and speech sufficient to conduct normal in-person and telephone conversations.
3. Work assignments are normally located in a work environment with light physical activity and require light physical effort.
4. May require lifting 25 pounds maximum or carrying any object weighing over 15 pounds.
