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Re: Joint message from Barton Health and LTUSD; Regular Board Meeting August 11; and Good News to Know

Good afternoon LTUSD friends and families,

In an on-going effort to collaborate on the status of COVID-19 and the impacts it is having on the reopening of our schools to in-person learning, LTUSD is meeting weekly with Barton Health to review and evaluate the most up to date and current data regarding case numbers, transmission rates, positivity rates, testing availability, and the status of South Lake Tahoe as a community within El Dorado County. These weekly meetings allow for LTUSD and community health providers to assess the local impacts and review data trends that will allow for decisions to be made every six weeks. This joint collaboration specifically looks at El Dorado County as a whole and the South Lake Tahoe community in relationship to Governor Newsom's criteria for allowing counties and Local Health Jurisdictions (LHJ) to remain off the monitoring list. The number of cases in South Lake Tahoe (LHJ) continues to be 3x the state threshold for the monitoring list, even though El Dorado County is not on the monitoring list. It is our goal to provide the community with a weekly update resulting from this collaborative partnership. We will provide the most up to date information that will allow our community to plan, as we know the school district plays such a vital role in supporting our students and families in our community. LTUSD, in accordance with the approved <u>Pandemic Plan</u>, will analyze the following data for the decision making process:

- Status on the Monitoring List
- Local and County Active Cases per 100,000 residents
- County Positivity rate (we don't have a local positivity rate)
- Trend metrics for increasing, decreasing or stable cases over a period of 14 days.
- Testing and Health System capacity (state guidelines require regular testing of staff)

LTUSD in partnership with Barton Health will utilize these data points to determine in six week increments, the instructional model for the following six weeks. Distance learning has been approved for August 31st through October 12th. The district will continue to

meet weekly, analyze the data, and determine on September 25th if we meet the criteria for moving into a hybrid instructional model. This will allow teachers and families to prepare for October 12 through November 20th.
