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# Re: LTUSD Welcomes You to the 20/21 School Year! Please read this very Important Message

Good afternoon LTUSD friends and families,

The first day of school, August 31, is just around the corner and we are very excited to embark on a dynamic, new distance learning experience with our families. As you are aware LTUSD adopted the LTUSD COVID-19 Pandemic Plan (En español) and we are preparing to begin the school year in Phase 1. We will be in Phase 1 for 6 weeks, with reassessment at the 4th week. At that time, our hope is that we will have met, or can project to meet, the criteria to move to the hybrid schedule on or about Oct. 12. The District understands that distance learning presents a range of difficulties for every family but we want to assure you that your teachers, administrators, and all staff members, intend to do their very best to engage, connect, and meet the needs of <u>every student</u>. The district thanks its families, staff, and community partners, for their support throughout the summer as we navigated this very challenging time - *together*.

#### **BACK TO SCHOOL**

Please read thoroughly to learn all the back to school information you will need for a smooth start to the school year! Be sure to read all updates from your school site as well to learn more details about your specific school.

<u>The AERIES PARENT PORTAL is now open</u>. ALL *RETURNING* STUDENTS MUST update their emergency contact information and review annual notifications online through the <u>Aeries Parent Portal</u>. Please follow the instructions carefully for information regarding <u>free & reduced meals</u> and <u>Chromebook Insurance</u>.

<u>CONFIDENTIAL FREE OR REDUCED MEAL APPLICATION</u> – Everyone that fills out the application, whether you qualify or not, automatically receives 50% off their Chromebook insurance! (It took me only 4 minutes and I'm saving \$30 for two kids!) The

application is **confidential and used internally only by the LTUSD food services department** to qualify your student for free or reduced meals. **Your information is not shared with any outside agencies and it does not affect your credit**. What it **does do** is provide your child with healthy meals during the school day and earns money for academic programs for your school!

**MEAL SERVICES will continue** while the district is in Phase 1 (distance learning.) The plan will look similar to the pick-up plan in place during the end of last school year, with additional bus stops and minor schedule changes. The schedule will be out soon.

AERIES SCHOOL COMMUNICATIONS PLATFORM: Communications is a simple tool that allows parents, students, and staff, to easily communicate and to remain up-to-date with district, school, and classroom announcements. Please note: By default, email, phone and text (SMS) are enabled at the start of each school year until the user elects to opt out. To customize your notification preferences follow these steps:

- Login into the <u>Aeries portal</u> and click on the <u>Communications Tab in the top</u> menu bar (<u>Not in the left column where it says "Aeries Communications" in Blue</u> and Red). <u>Portals</u>
- Once inside, you can customize your preferences by clicking on your initials inside the bubble icon in the upper left corner.
- If your preferred language is other than English make a selection in the "Personal Info" screen under "PREFERRED LANGUAGE" click the drop-down arrow.
- Click on "Notifications" under your initials.
- All of the boxes should be checked you must uncheck boxes if you do not want to receive the specified messages by either call, text (SMS), or email.
