NIXLE - Parent Texting Network from Drug Free Coalition As a parent, you are naturally concerned about your children's safety. As they grow older, one of those concerns centers on their potential exposure to drugs/substances of abuse and possible addiction. The mission of the South Tahoe Drug Free Coalition (DFC) is to prevent and reduce substance misuse in our youth. With a focus on nonjudgmental, factual education derived from evidence-based studies, the DFC provides a free parent texting network - Nixle. This is an opt-in program whereby an interested parent can choose to receive periodic texts (1-2 per month) identifying substance use trends seen locally in our schools and community, information about the drugs themselves, links to studies, and resources in our local area for assistance and treatment.
