Good afternoon LTUSD friends and families,

The District continued its second week of hybrid schedule at the elementary school sites and it continues to be a huge success thanks to the efforts and support of the entire community - thank you! We are on track for Middle School to start their hybrid schedule on November 2 and very happy to see that <u>El Dorado County Public Health</u> reports a consistently low COVID-19 testing positivity rate of 1%. We're obviously doing something right - let's keep it up! Please continue to use the <u>COVID-19 self-screening</u> tool daily and follow the <u>CDC recommendations for selecting</u>, wearing, and cleaning your masks (Spanish).

Yes on Prop 15. On October 13, the Board of Education adopted a <u>resolution in</u> <u>support of Proposition 15: Schools and Communities First Funding Act in 2020</u>, and asked for the community to vote in favor of Prop 15 on November's ballot. Prop 15, if passed, would bring approximately \$2.4 million to Lake Tahoe Unified School District, at a time when funding couldn't be more important. Our schools were already facing serious budget constraints before the pandemic, but now, after the pandemic, budget shortfalls are a stark reality. Tahoe Tribune/Mountain Democrat - An El Dorado County nonprofit held events the past two weekends to help disadvantaged and homeless middle and elementary school students in South Lake Tahoe... Each year Operation School Bell helps both recurring and new students. The events were held in collaboration with the El Dorado County Office of Education.

<u>CAFECITOS Elementary Meetings will be held every Thursday at 5:30pm</u> for all elementary schools, combined. Parents will learn how to navigate the online school system and track their child's progress through Canvas.

New green programs at local schools (Mt. News) South Tahoe High School students worked for over a year to develop a climate resolution which the Lake Tahoe Unified School District Board of Education adopted last month. The resolution calls for the board to ensure that all high school students graduate literate in climate change. The resolution also states that the school district should prepare students for growing job and career opportunities in green technologies, construction and restoration efforts, as society moves away from fossil fuels. Board member Bonnie Turnbull said, "Let's create

MEAL DELIVERY SCHEDULE Effective Monday, Oct. 12 - Be sure to check this link for changes to meal delivery. Breakfast and lunch is now offered to all children ages 0-18 at no charge through December 2020. Routes will be updated as needed. Buses will distribute meals at each bus stop listed and will depart bus stops at the designated time.
