Hello LTUSD friends and families,

Happy Earth Week! The schools were buzzing with all kinds of insightful activities, challenges, and stewardship education this week to boost "every day is earth day" awareness

Please remember that Monday holds a new, full-day bell schedule and transportation schedule for every school site, so be on the lookout for your school's messaging. We know that this year has been challenging and difficult for everyone, especially our kids, and we are working hard to continue expanding in-person instruction to the secondary students. The District is targeting May 17 for a shift to Phase 4 (traditional model). This would move all of our secondary students to the classroom 4 days per week. School administrators and all District departments are currently working out the details for welcoming all students to the STMS/STHS campuses collectively, with safety at the forefront.
