STUDENTS MUST review the Parent Annual Notifications and update their emergency contact information online through the <u>Aeries Parent Portal</u>. Please follow the instructions carefully for information regarding the <u>Education Benefit form</u> and <u>Chromebook Insurance</u>.

EDUCATION BENEFIT FORM: Every student who is under a certain income, learning English, or in foster care generates 20% more funding for our schools. In LTUSD these dollars are given to each school to increase or improve services for these students. Completing the Education Benefit Form ensures your school receives all available funds. Please <u>fill out the form here</u> - it only takes a few minutes and **everyone that** *fills out the application, whether you qualify or not, automatically receives 50% off*

their <u>Chromebook insurance</u>! Be sure to write or print your confirmation number to submit with your Chromebook insurance document.

MEAL SERVICES AND <u>BUS TRANSPORTATION</u> will continue to be **FREE** for all schools during the 21/22 school year, however the District asks that you please complete the Education Benefit Form so that schools can continue to receive supplemental funding as described above. 
