
#### **BOARD OF EDUCATION:**

**2022 School Board Elections:** Two seats are up for election on November 8, 2022 for Trustee Area 2 (Incumbent Brandi Bannister) and Trustee Area 5 (Incumbent Lauri Kemper). The Board uses a voting system of "Elections by Trustee Areas" which means that Board members must live in, and are elected only by the residents of, that area. .Trustee Area Maps may be viewed here.
