

<u>2022 School Board Elections</u>: Two seats are up for election on November 8, 2022 for Trustee Area 2 (Incumbent Brandi Bannister) and Trustee Area 5 (Incumbent Lauri Kemper). The Board uses a voting system of "Elections by Trustee Areas" which means that Board members must live in, and are elected only by the residents of, that area. <u>Trustee Area Maps may be viewed here</u>.
