

The Sky's the Limit at LTUSD!

2018 South Tahoe High graduate, Theresa Sandborn, is going into her final year at Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo. She interned this summer for Aerojet Rocketdyne, the company that made the engines for the Artemis missions which are set to bring the first woman and first person of color to the moon. The Artemis I launch was scrubbed earlier this week but is set to launch tomorrow. In her internship, Theresa wrote code to support tests of the engines as they get ready for launch. There are sensors on the engines for things like pressure and temperature, to ensure they are working properly. Her code takes the data from those sensors and compares it to previous tests of the engines to make sure they're behaving. Her code was used today to do a final checkup before tomorrow's launch. What an amazing Viking success story - congratulations Theresa!
