Affordable Connectivity Program (Wi-fi): Congress created the Affordable Connectivity Program, a new long-term, \$14 billion program, to help ensure we can afford the connections we need for work, school, health care and more for a long time.

Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) helps income-eligible households pay their energy bill or heating fuel provider. Eligible homeowners or renters may qualify to have a specific payment amount credited to their electric utility account or receive financial assistance in obtaining firewood, propane, pellets or heating oil. 
