IN THE SCHOOLS

Free Math Tutoring at LTCC for all LTUSD Students! South Tahoe High Homecoming Parade goes through town South Tahoe Now - An assortment of decorated floats and vehicles, a drum corps, dance and cheer teams, and other walkers joined the South Tahoe High Homecoming Parade through town on Friday. The theme of this year's parade was "Disney."

South Lake Tahoe 11-year-olds kayak around Lake Tahoe as summer science project – South Tahoe Now - Tobin Grey, Conner Langevin, Benji Blower, and Kaya Ferry, sixth-graders at South Tahoe Middle School, kayaked the 72-mile perimeter of Lake Tahoe and along the way, conducted water quality testing, did nature journaling, learned about tree biodiversity, met with scientists gathering data about microplastics, picked up trash, identified native and non-native species, and monitored for invasive

species. Much of their gathered information was uploaded to the Citizen Science App created by the UC Davis Tahoe Environmental Research Center (TERC).

New wellness clinic will serve South Tahoe Middle School – Tahoe Daily Tribune - South Tahoe Middle School will soon have a wellness clinic. Sierra Child & Family Services is a local nonprofit with its main focus on collective experience and interests directed at providing for the care and welfare of children. The nonprofit opened a wellness clinic in partnership with El Dorado County Behavioral Health, Lake Tahoe Unified School District and Tahoe Youth and Family Services a month before school ended last year at South Tahoe High School. In less than a month the middle school will have one too.

New benches and tables up for sponsorship in South Tahoe High School quad – South Tahoe Now - South Tahoe Vikings Booster Club is starting 2022-23 off with a bang and they are inviting the South Lake Tahoe community to join in the fun. This year, Boosters is coordinating the rejuvenation of the South Tahoe High School (STHS) QUAD - the center of campus - for the students to have a great outdoor space to hang out in.

Special Needs Community Night brings families together in South Lake Tahoe South Tahoe Now Parents of special needs children in South Lake Tahoe have been finding support and resources since February through a new connected network of families. Lake Tahoe AleWorX at The Crossing at Tahoe Valley hosted a Special Needs Community Night recently, bringing parents together for what participants are calling the most successful gathering to date.

Affordable Connectivity Program (Wi-fi): Congress created the [Affordable Connectivity Program](#), a new long-term, \$14 billion program, to help ensure we can afford the connections we need for work, school, health care and more for a long time.

Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) helps income-eligible households pay their energy bill or heating fuel provider. Eligible homeowners or renters may qualify to have a specific payment amount credited to their electric utility account or receive financial assistance in obtaining firewood, propane, pellets or heating oil.
