
The LCAP is a three-year plan that describes the goals, actions, services, and expenditures to support positive student outcomes that address state and local priorities. The LCAP provides an opportunity for local educational agencies (LEAs) to share their stories of how, what, and why programs and services are selected to meet their local needs. The LCAP is a tool for our District to set goals, plan actions, and leverage resources to meet those goals to improve student outcomes. The District agrees that STEA (South Tahoe Educators' Association) is the exclusive representative of the certificated employees and has the right to consult, provide feedback and recommendations on LCAP goals and actions.


In alignment with the focus on stakeholder engagement, the parties agree the following procedures shall be used:

1. The parties shall jointly manage the LCAPAC (Local Control Accountability Advisory Committee).
 - a. The committee shall be composed of twenty-seven members, to include ten District members, sixteen STEA Association members, and the President of the local California School Employees Association (CSEA).
 - ai. The District members shall be the Superintendent or designee, one Principal from each site, and two District Administrators.
 - aii. The STEA Association members shall be the Association President or designee, two Association members from each school site, and one Association member from Mt. Tallac Continuation High School, Al Tahoe School, and Special Education, respectively.
 - aiii. Each party shall select their own committee members within the categories delineated in ai and aii.
2. The committee shall meet three times each year, starting in November of each school year.
3. The committee shall review current and proposed goals, actions, services, expenditures and provide feedback and recommend modifications, adjustments, or changes to LCAP goals and actions.

Note: This memorandum of understanding replaces the MOU dated December 15, 2017 regarding the CCSSAC.
