


SELPA FUNDING ALLOCATION AGREEMENT




Tahoe-Alpine funding is based on the SELPA Special Education Funding Exhibit per AB 602. Per the February certification for 99/00, the SELPA funding rate including COLA, special disabilities factor, and equalization, is \$441.40. When special disabilities adjustment, program specialist/regional services, and low incidence monies are added and divided by prior year ADA of 5,570.87, an additional \$55.52 is added to the rate which then becomes \$496.92. The actual funded amount is \$479.94 (\$16.98 less due to proration factors).

The 99/00 Alpine funded allocation (based on PL 94-142 and prior J50 certification) equals \$127,841. This amount divided by current P2 ADA equals a funding rate of \$672.85 (\$127,841/190 ADA).

Due to the disparity between the SELPA rate and Alpine rate, the Districts have agreed that Alpine shall continue to receive funding of \$127,841 until the rates equalize. Therefore, the 00/01 allocation is agreed to be \$127,841. However, representatives of the two Districts shall meet yearly after the P2 J18/19 report to review the terms of the agreement. Approval by each district superintendent of schools is necessary for this funding to occur.
