GENERAL COVID GUIDANCE - VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS

This guidance provides direction on music and performing arts activities within LTUSD. This guidance applies to Visual Arts, Music, Chorus, Band, Orchestra, Strings and Theatre activities.

- All student participants in any extracurricular school based visual & performing, music, or theatre events will participate in weekly surveillance testing in preparation, at least one week prior to any visual & performing arts activity or performance, **regardless of vaccination status.**
- All students participating in these events will test and results will be shared with school.
- Face coverings are to be worn at all times when participating in the activity or performance.
- Face coverings are required at all times while riding on LTUSD transportation.
- All spectators or audience participants must remain masked at all times while at an indoor event.
- Physical distancing and outdoor spaces should be exercised when possible. Indoor visual and performing arts activities including band, choir, theatre, performances and/or competitions will have maximum audience allowances to ensure appropriate spacing and distancing recommendations can be made based on current CDC and CDPH guidance. The location of the event will determine if there is a need to limit audience members.
- No food/or drink that requires removal of a mask will be permitted at indoor events.
- All students, staff, and spectators who have symptoms of illness should stay home in order to prevent the spread of illness to others.
- LTUSD will continue to monitor the COVID-19 transmission rates in South Lake Tahoe Region and CDPH recommendations to update this guidance.

PROTOCOL WHEN A STUDENT PERFORMER TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

COVID-19 positive persons are on Standard Quarantine- 10 days, no school or extracurricular activities. The student may return after 10 days IF symptoms have greatly improved and no fever for 24 hours. DAY 1 is the day after the onset of symptoms OR a positive test. Any student with symptoms should immediately contact their school nurse for further guidance and district quarantine procedures. This guidance is not intended to replace that of their primary health care provider.
